

How to find a general practitioner (GP) in České Budějovice

A Guide for PhD students

If you are a PhD student in České
Budějovice and need to register with a
general practitioner (GP), the following
information will help you navigate the
healthcare system in the Czech
Republic.

Choose from a selection of male and female doctors during registration.

How to register?

- Register with the doctor: Scan the QR code. Switch to English and Fill out a form via virtual nurse "SestraEmmy" with your personal details to create a request.
- **First appointment**: During your first visit, the doctor may perform a basic health check-up and review your medical records.

What do you need to register?

- Health insurance: To register with a doctor, you will need valid health insurance (European Health Insurance Card or commercial health insurance for students). The virtual nurse will guide you through the system and show you where to find your insurance number.
- Non-EU students with visa or residence permit: If you are from the EU, you can use your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). If you are a non-EU PhD over the age of 26 and have at least a part-time job at the University of South Bohemia or BC, then your insurance is covered by your employer and you are entitled to health care as Czech students.

What to do in case of illness?

- Contact your GP: If you need medical help, call your GP or schedule an appointment.
- Emergency service: In case of an emergency or accident, visit the emergency room. Emergency service address: B. Němcové 585/54, 370 01 České Budějovice 7. Upper part of the hospital complex, on the groud floor of PAVILION C, within the Emergency Admission Area entrance through the main entrance of the hospital complex. Scan QR code for a map.
